

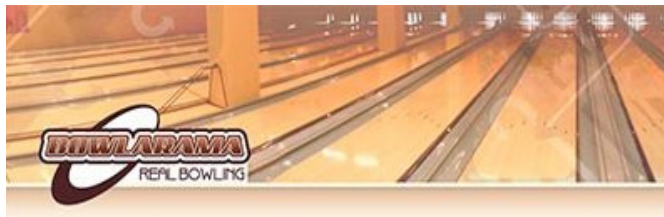

TOURNAMENT RULES AND REGULATIONS

This Tournament is a scratch event. Entry is open to all current TBNZ and WorldBowling Registered Players, who must attain the age of 50 or above in the year of this competition. Proof of age is required if the entrant has not previously bowled as a senior in a TBNZ or WorldBowling sanctioned tournament.

This tournament will be TBNZ sanctioned and all games will be played in accordance with TBNZ playing rules.

All bowlers who enter this tournament **may be tested** for compliance with the TBNZ Anti-Doping Policy. Many drugs remain present in the body for months after use. If you are unsure about your drug free status, do NOT enter this tournament.

No smoking is permitted from commencement of practice to conclusion of play on each day. This includes when lane changes are made, or breakdowns occur.

There is a separate division for men and ladies, with a prize pool that is paid out according to the entries in each division.

TBNZ ranking points will be allocated according to the placing achieved in each of the men's and ladies divisions.

There will be two squads which will have a maximum of 40 bowlers combined for the men's and ladies divisions. There will be a maximum of 4 bowlers per pair of lanes.

Each competitor will bowl 8 games (in blocks of 2 games) on Saturday and 8 games (in blocks of 2 games) on Sunday. The number of lanes to move after each block will be determined by the tournament director, with the intent of trying (as far as is practicable) to ensure that each bowler experiences similar use of the lanes in play.

In the event there are insufficient entries to run 2 squads, Squad 2 will take precedence to cater for out of towners to facilitate their travel arrangements and Squad 1 will be cancelled.

Placings will be decided on total pinfalls. Should a tie occur for 1st place, a one game playoff will decide the winner. Should a tie occur for any other placings, the prize money will be split.

ENTRY FEE is \$165, which comprises \$80 lane fees, \$5 TBNZ tournament fee, and \$80 prize fund.

To facilitate payment of entry fees, bowlers must check in at least 15 minutes before the scheduled start time. The Tournament Director may permit a late entry from a new competitor, the use of a pacer, or reallocation of bowlers per lane as the Tournament Director deems appropriate. Five minutes warm up will be given prior to the start of each day of bowling.

All competitors will be required to be suitably attired, with a clean and tidy standard of dress. This must include either a short sleeved collared bowling shirt or a branded bowling shirt. Males must wear dress trousers or tailored shorts requiring a belt. Females may wear skirts, dress trousers, or shorts of any length. Track pants, cargo pants, stirrup pants, or any denim material are not permitted.

A deposit of \$50 is required no later than 7 days prior to event to secure a place. The balance of \$115 can be paid at any time before the Saturday check-in. Entries after this close off date will only be accepted if the centre manager decides this assists with the centre's allocation of lanes. The centre manager's decision in this respect is final, so please ensure you have paid your deposit by the required time.

All entry fees will be fully refundable up to 7 days prior to the event. No refunds will be made within the 7 days prior to the tournament.

Protests are to be given verbally to the Tournament Director within 10 minutes of the occurring infraction and confirmed in writing within 10 minutes of completion of the days play.

Any matter not covered in these rules will be decided by the Tournament Director, whose decision will be final.
